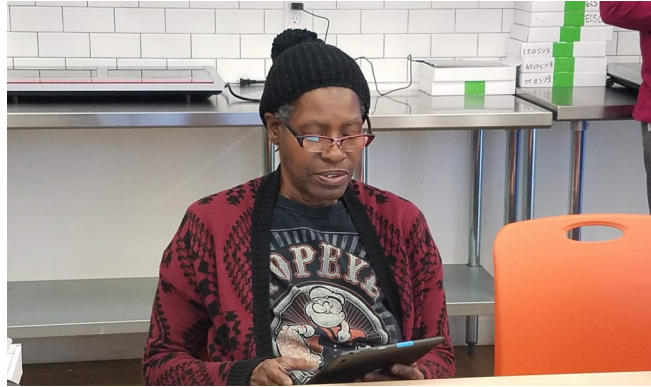


Community Tech Network (CTN), in partnership with the Department of Disability and Aging Services, wants to ensure all older adults can connect safely and independently to the internet from home. **You have received this brochure because a partner has referred you indicating that you are in need of some, or all, of the following which you do not currently possess:**

- ◆ A device, larger than a phone, that will allow you to access the internet.
- ◆ An internet connection, aside from that provided through your phone, that will allow you to participate in video conferences and communicate with family.
- ◆ The digital skills required to utilize the internet.



Cost to Participate:

This program is for San Francisco residents who are 60 years of age or older and live alone. Priority will be made for anyone with an income level below the poverty line.

In order to qualify for a FREE Android tablet, the applicant:

- ◆ Must not possess a digital device, other than a mobile or smartphone
- ◆ Must be referred by a partnering organization
- ◆ Must agree to participate in 5 hours of basic training with a CTN staff member

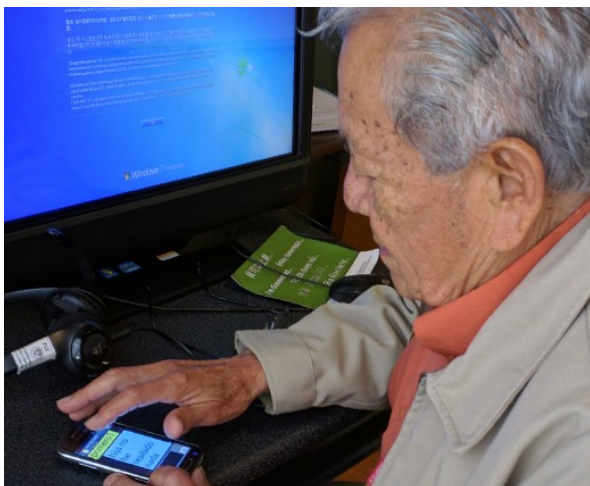

Home Connect will give you the opportunity to learn how to use the internet and have your questions answered immediately with your own Digital Coach.

Minimize the harsh impacts of social isolation by connecting online with friends, family, health providers, online groups and more!

Never skip a doctor's appointment again by learning how to access telemedicine services with your healthcare provider!

Getting online might be confusing or intimidating, but we're here to help! Here's what you can expect from CTN:

- ◆ A staff member will assist you in setting up the internet. From identifying the plan, to connecting the internet service provider, to ensuring you submit the right eligibility paperwork.
- ◆ We will ship you a tablet (Android not iPad), along with training material that you get to keep after completing 5 hours of basic training.
- ◆ A CTN Trainer will connect with you by phone and your basic training will begin. Upon completion of your basic training, you will have the option to continue training with a CTN Volunteer Digital Coach.
