Food and Health Access	<b>Community Living Campaign (CLC)</b>	<p>Community Living Campaign (CLC) has Food Delivery Networks that bring groceries and human connection to older adults and people with disabilities who can't get to food pantries on their own.</p> <p>For folks who have a hard time making it to food pantries, the Food Delivery Networks coordinate neighbors to call, stop by with groceries, and check in.
